CAPITALISM AT RISK vied for the lead along the inside, then was edging away from MANY CROWNS when he drifted out under left-handed urging impeding that rival at the wire. MANY CROWNS vied for the lead outside CAPITALISM AT RISK to deep stretch, then was weakening when he clipped that rivals heels at the wire. FRENCH POLITICS chased the early pace, dropped back racing around the turn, then swung out for the drive and closed to gain the show. TIKITOCKI saved ground and failed to menace. ONE PROUD GIRL showed early foot, raced three wide around the turn and tired. DREAMING OF BELLA rated off the pace after being caught in tight at the start, faltered in the drive. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND THE RIDER OF MANY CROWNS LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF CAPITALISM AT RISK FOR INTERFERENCE NEARING THE FINISH. THE STEWARDS DETERMINED THE INCIDENT HAD NO EFFECT ON THE OUTCOME AND THE RACE WAS MADE OFFICIAL.
