Footnotes

SIR BEAR unhurried early, advanced into contention along the inside on the far turn, angled outside the leaders for the drive and rallied under pressure to be up late. PLEASANT BREEZE vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear under pressure in midstretch but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. BROKEN VOW tracked the pace along the inside, angled three wide to make his run entering the stretch but couldn't gain in the final eighth. VISION AND VERSE rated in striking position after being steadied when caught in tight entering the main track, made a run three wide on the far turn to loom a threat entering the stretch, then tired. GANDER bumped with CAT'S AT HOME soon after the start, raced with the pace between horses into the backstretch, then faltered. CAT'S AT HOME allowed to settle after being jostled between rivals soon after the start, raced three wide on the far turn and faded. DUCKHORN bumped with CAT'S AT HOME soon after the start, vied for the lead from the outside into the far turn and faded. SALTY NOTE was never close. WITH ANTICIPATION showed little.
