SCORPION set the pace under pressure along the inside, then drew clear through the stretch under pressure. TWIN SHOOTER unhurried early, rallied along the rail to prove second best. PAGING outrun early, closed along the inside to be up for the show. LAKE AGAWAM pressed the pace outside SCORPION into the stretch and weakened. SILVER AWARD failed to menace. ELEVEN WEST raced three wide on the turn and tired. JOE'S SON JOEY chased the pace around the turn and faltered. RUNNING RAHY was outrun.
