CATARIA reserved early, rallied and split rivals in the stretch to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole, then was all out to prevail. SWEET PROBLEM rated off the pace, advanced into contention three wide around the turn and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. JULES FOR A. J. off slowly, raced three wide on the turn, angled out widest of all in the stretch and closed well. FORMAL FANNY showed speed along the inside, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, then gave way late. SHIMMY SHAKE broke poorly, advanced along the inside around the turn to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't gain late. FOXIE BERTIE failed to menace. FLY ME ALI chased the pace to inside the eighth pole and tired.
