Footnotes

CHELOKEE well placed while saving ground, dropped well back when checked entering the far turn, continued to save ground into the stretch, then rallied under pressure and split rivals to be up late. FOR YOU REppo rated off the pace after breaking slowly, rallied to catch HIGH ACT nearing the eighth pole and continued on with good courage while unable to hold off the winner late. SIGHTSEEING allowed to settle, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. HIGH ACT set the pace along the rail into the stretch and gave way. SACRIFICE BUNT outran after being steadied entering the first turn, swung out for the stretch run and couldn't gain late. HIGHEST DEGREE unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, then was steadied in behind SACRIFICE BUNT entering the stretch and failed to threaten. ROMAN'S RUN tracked the pace into the far turn and tired. ZOOBSTICK prompted the pace outside HIGH ACT for more than a half mile, then faltered. SILVER EXPRESS showed early foot and faded.
