**Footnotes**

CORINTHIAN stalked the pace outside NOBLE CAUSEWAY, moved to take over from that rival three wide midway of the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to last over HESANOLDSALT. The latter, stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside NOBLE CAUSEWAY on the far turn to reach the attending position, angled outside CORINTHIAN at the top of the stretch, then responded to pressure and was gaining on that rival at the wire. A. P. ARROW broke awkwardly, tracked the pace three wide into the stretch, then finished willingly and was getting to the top ones late. NOBLE CAUSEWAY quickly moved to the fore, made the pace off the rail into the far turn and tired. REHOBOTH reserved in striking position off the pace, faltered leaving the far turn. SUMMER BOOK rated off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and faded.
