INTERCOASTAL set the pace along the rail, drew well clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to last over. DUCDUC rated off the pace after bumping hard with CLEAN SHOT in the early going, raced three wide around far turn and was gaining on the winner at the finish. SUNSHINE RAMBLER well placed racing along the rail, steadied entering the far turn, continued to save ground into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. CROSS VILLAGE stalked

the pace into the stretch and had no response when asked. WAT rated off the pace, lacked a rally. CLEAN SHOT steadied when bumped between rivals soon after the start, saved ground, then steadied again at the top of the stretch and never threatened. ALGEIBA chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired. GONE STRAIGHT raced in contention three wide around the far turn and faltered. LT. JOHN was not a factor. KNACK was outrun after being checked when he bumped with CLEAN SHOT in the early going. OUR SUN chased the pace into the stretch and faded. U S TREASURY raced three wide and was through after a half mile.
