TIZ MARIAND bobbled at the start, chased the pace three wide, moved to take over at the quarter pole, then was fully extended to hold off BOZIQUE. The latter, rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, swung out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. SARAVA'S DIVA advanced down the backstretch to chase the pace off the rail, eased off for the stretch run and didn't do enough late. MYSISTERJOSEPHINE rated off the pace, improved her position in the drive without threatening. RAPID DISTINCTION set the pace off the rail, responded when headed by TIZ MARIAND on the turn, then tired in the drive. SELL SELL SELL stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch and faltered. DIPLOMATIC IMMUNITY chased the pace four wide around the turn and faded.
