PRETENTIOUS steadied at the start, saved ground into the stretch, came outside the leaders and rallied under pressure to up in the final strides. RASH chased the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach the leaders, then just edged GULCH LEGACY for the place while being outfinished. GULCH LEGACY stalked the pace, moved to gain a slim lead just past midway of the far turn, then gave way grudgingly in the final strides. SWEETEST STAR made the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn and tired. PROBING allowed to settle, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. CHEROKEE GOSSIP was outrun. GOOD AND STORMY well placed into the far turn, faltered. HAYLEY'S DANCER showed little. GOLDEN GLIMMER chased the pace to the far turn, stopped and was eased in the final eighth.
