LILAH chased the pace four wide, moved to take over leaving the turn and drew away while being ridden out. PETRINA ABOVE vied for the lead three wide into the stretch, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. CRAFTY BRAT outrun after bumping with FOLLOW ME HOME soon after the start, saved ground around the turn, angled out and closed to be up for the show. BIG CHEQUE bumped with FOLLOW ME HOME soon after the start, vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, then gave way. SELF RISING unhurried early, raced four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. MARIONETTE steadied leaving the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and tired. FOLLOW ME HOME bumped and steadied from between rivals soon after the start, raced three wide on the turn and was not a factor. HONGKONG CHARLEY vied for the lead between horses into the turn and faltered.
