MISTER FOTIS vied for the lead outside MIDDLE EARTH, drew clear in the stretch, then was all out to last over SIR GREELEY. The latter, vied for the early lead, was outmoted on the turn, chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then responded to pressure and rallied to just miss. UNIVERSAL FORM unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and found his best stride late. JUDITHS WILD RUSH reserved after being caught in tight on the backstretch, moved into contention five wide on the turn but couldn't gain late. WILD TALE failed to menace. MIDDLE EARTH vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. SILVER TRAIN stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then had no response when asked. BULL RANCH saved ground and failed to be a factor. PIRATE KING showed brief speed, raced four wide on the turn and faltered.
