MOTORCYCLE TOM reserved racing along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then drew off under urging. STIRRUP EXCITMENT pressed the pace in hand outside STARSHIP VOYAGE, moved to take over leaving the turn, made the pace into the stretch, then was no match for the winner. REGAL OFFICER unhurried after breaking poorly, passed tired rivals for the show. RADIO RELAY chased the pace around the turn, angled out for the drive and tired. STARSHIP VOYAGE set the pace under pressure along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. GUN HIGHWAY chased the pace to midway of the turn, then faded.
