Footnotes

UMBRAGGIO outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a rush to be up late. WIRE CUTTER tracked the pace along the inside, eased out and rallied to gain the lead in deep stretch but was outfinished. FRANCISCO'S BOY allowed to settle after being steadied in the early going, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out and rallied for the show while being steadied in traffic late. GROVE HALL unhurried early, saved ground and finished willingly along the rail. AIR UNION showed speed from the outset, sprinted to a long lead racing down the backstretch and into the far turn, made the pace

along the inside to past the sixteenth pole, then shortened stride. ROCKY FORTUNE tracked the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then flattened out. HUGO LIGHT showed brief speed, chased AIR UNION into the far turn after losing the lead to that rival, then gave way. VOLUNTEER KITTEN rated off the pace, saved ground while moving up around the far turn, then tired in the drive. TOTAL REWARD drifted in at the start and was not a factor. JETTIES BEACH was done early after being caught in tight on the first turn. BARK SCORPION steadied in the early going and was through after six furlongs.
