Footnotes

MR. RYDER well placed on the rail, moved up around the far turn, steadied in behind GREEN BLUFF in early stretch, eased out for room and rallied to be up late. SLEWS ANSWER reserved off the pace, lacked room in behind a wall of horses in the stretch, angled out and finished willingly to be up for the place. LONGBOARDER chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the sixteenth pole, then gave way late. CHEYENNE NATION unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to just miss the place and show. JAMES STREET chased the pace, made a run at GREEN BLUFF on the far turn, then weakened. CAPITAL MARKET rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention but didn't do enough late. GREEN BLUFF set the pace along the rail, repulsed a bid from JAMES STREET on the far turn, maintained the advantage to nearing the sixteenth pole, then tired. GREEN LITE SPECIAL was no factor while saving ground.
