BREAK UP THE GAME unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn, eased out for the stretch run, then rallied under pressure along the outside to be up late. NINETY SCHILLINGS tracked the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. BOMBER BOY chased the pace off the rail, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole but couldn't resist the top ones late. JACK LONDON showed speed along the inside to past the eighth pole, then weakened. FIRE WITH FIRE tracked the leaders off the rail into the stretch but had no response when asked. BENERGY chased the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. BORREGO'S BOY saved ground and never threatened. DURATION off slowly, was not a factor. FOLLOW THE RHYTHM raced four wide and was done early.
