Footnotes

CASINO HOST rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn, then rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and edged away. IMHOTEP unhurried after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. ENDURING STAR outran early, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to be just up for the show. BOMBAGUIA outran FEDERAL EXCHANGE for the lead around the first turn and eased to the inside, made the pace along the rail to past the eighth pole, then weakened. KENTUCKY REIGN reserved racing along the rail, was blocked in behind the leaders in midstretch, angled outside those rivals for room and finished willingly. EMPIRICIST off slowly, was allowed to settle, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and closed with a belated rally. DEED IT IS stalked the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then gave way. FEDERAL EXCHANGE outran for the lead, chased the pace into the stretch, made a run at the leader in midstretch, then tired. SYROS eased back off the leaders to stalk the pace, then was steadied when caught in tight at the top of the stretch and failed to recover. NIEDERZEL was never a threat after breaking slowly. PLEASANT RUN was not a factor. MIDDIE steadied in the early going and was through after a half mile.
