**Footnotes**

EL WINDO set the pace along the rail, repulsed a bid from two rivals leaving the far turn and edged clear, then was all out to just last over PAGAN RULER. The latter, unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss. LAVER chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach the winner on the far turn, was outmoved by that rival into the stretch, then was coming on again at the finish while just being edged for the place. LAMAR VALLEY allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn and finished willingly. BIZZIE LIGHT reserved racing along the rail after being steadied racing into the first turn, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch, then flattened out. CANTRUSHPERFECTION tracked the pace four wide around the far turn and tired. HAVINABREW was through after a half mile. DIPLOMATIC CODE chased the pace, made a run to try the winner on the far turn, then faltered. CLAM BAKE was done early.
