Footnotes

BROTHER NICK steadied twice in the early going to avoid JUST PLAYIN AROUND, moved quickly through inside that rival to gain the advantage entering the first turn, opened a long lead racing down the backstretch, responded when challenged by MEAN SAX and JUST PLAYIN AROUND at the quarter pole to increase his advantage, then was fully extended to prevail in a game effort. MEAN SAX stalked the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command with BROTHER NICK at the quarter pole but was outgamed by that rival to the wire while just saving the place. CUSTER saved ground after being steadied in the run to the first turn, rallied along the rail to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while just missing the place. FEARLESS EAGLE rated off the pace, saved ground and finished willingly. UNCLE INDY allowed to settle, closed with a belated rally along the outside. ROCK IN BAGE (BRZ) bumped with CONSERVATIVE and checked in the early going, raced in contention three wide around the far turn, then didn't do enough late. EL CRESPO reserved early, closed ground late without threatening. JUST PLAYIN AROUND angled in early causing crowding, chased the pace, made a run to reach

near even terms for command at the quarter pole, then gave way. CONSERVATIVE checked when he bumped with ROCK IN BAGE in the early going, saved ground and failed to menace. LIME RICKEY was not a factor. TIERRA DEL TIGRE tracked the pace into the far turn and tired. TODAY'S MAN trailed.
