SALARY DRIVE chased the pace three wide, moved up to engage DELIGHTFUL DAWN at the quarter pole, vied with that rival to past the eighth pole, then edged away. PINCH PIE reserved early, advanced four wide around the turn to loom a threat but couldn't get to the winner while closing to prove best of the rest. DELIGHTFUL DAWN showed speed off the rail, responded when challenged by SALARY DRIVE at the quarter pole, vied with that rival to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. EL BENDINAT tracked the pace along the rail, made a run to reach the leaders at the quarter pole, then tired in the drive. MICHELLE'S TRIP rated off the pace, faltered leaving the turn. ERMA LEE was chasing the pace when steadied to avoid running up on the leaders nearing the end of the backstretch, remained in contention to nearing the stretch, then faded.
