Footnotes

TOQUE steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch, stalked the pace into the stretch, rallied to take over at the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended hold off HENDERSON. The latter, outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed well for the place. HARBOR RIDGE chased the pace three wide, moved to take over on the turn, made the pace to sixteenth pole, then weakened. WINNER JAK reserved early, rallied four wide to reach near even terms for command on the turn, tried HARBOR RIDGE to inside the eighth pole, then steadied to avoid bumping that rival and gave way. AGAIN ELEVEN allowed to settle, raced five wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. SOUPERMAN HIMSELF raced four wide and tired. CELLARS CABERNET well placed early, raced three wide around the turn and faltered. A QUESTION OF TIME chased the pace along the inside, made a run to reach the leaders entering the turn, then faded. DIAMOND SHIEK steadied leaving the chute and was done early. FREDRO set the pace off the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then had nothing left. DEPUTY INSPECTOR showed early foot and stopped.
