JUST A MINER set the pace under pressure racing off the rail, edged away approaching the eighth pole and was under pressure to prevail. LUSH forced the pace along the inside and proved second best. CONCIELO reserved off the pace, saved ground around the turn and rallied while unable to catch the top ones. TIGER RIDGE failed to menace. COLORADO DRIVE was away slowly and ducked in bumping TUT'S TAVERN at the start, then was not a factor. TUT'S TAVERN was outrun after being bumped at the start. BOREAS racing along the rail, was through early. STAIRWAY TO SUCCES showed early foot and faded.
