Footnotes

PAISLEY PARK rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the far turn, angled out and rallied to take over inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. SILET outrun early, steadied to avoid running up on heels on the far turn, angled out and rallied to be up for the place. MELODY OF COLORS eased back off the leaders on the first turn, stalked the pace into the far turn, made a run to try the leader in the stretch but was outfinished. MSBAILEYSCREAM showed early speed, was outmoved by MECKE'S PRINCESS racing down the backstretch, chased that rival along the inside into the stretch and weakened. MECKE'S PRINCESS showed speed, edged clear racing down the backstretch while angling to the inside, made the pace to past the eighth pole and gave way. GIVE AND TAKE reserved early, angled four wide on the far turn and lacked a late response. HOTTENTOT unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to be a factor. TUSCANY LIGHT tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and faltered. SUPER BLUE (CHI) allowed to settle, was saving ground when checked approaching the quarter pole, then faded. LET'S TOUR chased the pace, stopped abruptly racing down the backstretch, then was pulled up on the far turn and vanned off.
