MAGICAL AFFAIR allowed to settle, angled out on the far turn, rallied to catch STARSHIP ANGEL just inside the eighth pole and was all out to prevail. STARSHIP ANGEL tracked the pace, angled out on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead briefly at the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner while clearly second best. LASTFUL APPEAL saved ground after being bumped and squeezed back at the start, swung out for the stretch run, then closed to be up for the show. RHYTHM AND RHYME tracked the pace, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. CAPE KAROO bumped with LASTFUL APPEAL at the start, saved ground into the far turn, angled out and advanced to reach contention in midstretch, then tired. PERFECT FOR YOU failed to menace. DISCREET EMPIRE was not a factor. DEPUTY EMPRESS outrun after she dwelt at the start, advanced along the rail around the far turn to loom a threat, then faltered. CELEBRATING LOVE chased the pace, moved to take over on the backstretch while angling to the inside, made the pace

into the stretch and faded. SMART POLICY showed little after being knocked into LASTFUL APPEAL at the start. SEAQUOIA BLUE bumped hard with SMART POLICY at the start, showed speed along the inside into the backstretch, remained in contention to midway of the far turn, then had nothing left. DAME URSULA (GB) was through after a half mile.
