Footnotes

YIPPETY YIP reserved racing along the rail, angled out for room in the stretch and rallied to be up late. TIGER WITH A T set the pace under pressure along the rail, edged clear in midstretch but couldn't resist the winner late. MILICAT saved ground after breaking slowly, was caught in traffic on the far turn, made a run between rivals to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain her bid. SMARTGABRIELLE pressed the pace outside TIGER WITH A T into the stretch, then weakened. FIRST IS BEST rated off the pace, raced three wide and lacked a late response. PRINCESS WESTLY unhurried early, passed tired rivals. ELLE CASHAREAU stalked the pace into the stretch, angled to the rail and gave way. POETIC FAN stalked the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. PURPLE MOONLIGHT stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then faltered. KELLIHER failed to menace. DELTA WEEKEND was outrun. FANCY STEPPER was no factor after being checked on the first turn.
