Footnotes

DUBAI WONDER unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run, then rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and edged away. LANCE STUNNING reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run, then rallied to dead heat with MAGIC MIDDLETON. The latter, allowed to settle, raced four wide around the far turn, then rallied to finish on even terms for the place while unable to match strides with the winner. DANCING LOUNGE outrun after breaking slow and being steadied at the start, swung wide for the stretch run, then closed well to just miss the place. FLY RIDE rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then weakened. FRANCESCO PUNCH stalked the pace three wide, made a run to gain a slim lead nearing the quarter pole, maintained that advantage to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. HE'S SPECTACULAR taken in hand early, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention but had no late response. DUPES off slowly, advanced into contention around the far turn, then was caught in traffic in the stretch and tired. SPEED AVENUE vied for the lead outside ARI'S PRIDE into the far turn, then faltered. ARI'S PRIDE vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the quarter pole and faded. JACK B NIMBLE (IRE) was outrun after being steadied in the early going. RUTHERFORD B. was tracking the pace along the inside when steadied on the far turn and dropped back.
