Footnotes

PISTOL PEG set the pace along the inside, then drifted out in early stretch and was fully extended to hold off PERFECT EMBRACE. The latter, off slowly, stalked the pace three wide, was angled inside PISTOL PEG in early stretch, then rallied to just miss. FRIENDLY SELECTION rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and finished willingly to be up for the show. SPRING BEAUTY reserved racing along the rail, made a run to reach the leaders inside the eighth pole, then flattened out. GATOR'S TRACKS prompted the pace outside PISTOL PEG, then weakened in the drive. SLEWIE JONES unhurried after breaking poorly, closed with a mild response. LUCKY AFTERNOON was not a factor. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND THE RIDER OF PERFECT EMBRACE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF PISTOL PEG FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
