MORIAH RISING off slowly, chased the pace along the rail to deep stretch, then rallied to be up in time. STREET FLEET showed speed off the rail to deep stretch and yielded. RED OVER BLUE pressed the pace three wide to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. BREW BLESSINGS broke slow and steadied at the start, saved ground around the turn, swung out for the stretch run, then passed tired rivals. GOLD KNIFE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and tired. WHERE IS WILDER reserved off the pace, saved ground and faltered. WHY SHOULD I was through early. SWEET BUTTERFLY bounced around between rivals at the start, chased the pace four wide around the turn and faded. STARSHIP TACTICAL was no factor after being steadied

when she bumped with SWEET BUTTERFLY several times at the start. CYNTHIA'S NEW CAR bumped hard by SWEET BUTTERFLY at the start, was done soon after entering the turn. MISS TERINA was outrun while racing four wide. LARAMIE PLAINS showed little after being caught in tight early.
