EMERY BOARD stalked the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then dueled with INDY GLORY to the wire and prevailed. INDY GLORY prompted the pace outside BABY HELEN, then dueled with EMERY BOARD through the stretch and was edged to the wire. UNRESTRAINED reserved early, made a run four wide on the far turn to reach the leaders, was outmoved in the stretch, then was gaining slowly on the top ones at the finish. SOUND OF THE WEST unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and failed to threaten. BABY HELEN bobbled at the start, showed speed along the inside into the stretch and tired. MOMENTS OF JOY raced in striking position while saving ground, then faltered in the drive.
