JUSTIFICATION stalked the pace off the rail, rallied to take over leaving the far turn and drew clear through the stretch under urging. QUEST tracked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to gain the place while unable to match strides with the winner in the final eighth. DOC WILD rated off the pace, was caught in tight quarters on the first turn, rallied off the rail to loom a threat in midstretch, then flattened out. PAROSE outrun early, raced four wide on the far turn and passed tired rivals. M B SEA broke awkwardly and was never a factor. SEBASTIAN LIGHT set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch and tired. ALEGORICO (ARG) was outrun. GOLDEN CONCORDE raced three wide and faltered. PRIVATE RYAN well placed for a half mile, faded entering the far turn and was eased.
