SPRING WALTZ unhurried while saving ground into the stretch, eased out and split rivals to gain the lead just past the eighth pole, then drew away under pressure. TESSA BLUE chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead in early stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final eighth. GOLDEN VELVET steadied from close quarters racing into the first turn, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in midstretch but had no further response. ALTESSE failed to menace. PEACH FLAMBE set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then tired. CAT CAN DO saved ground and was not a factor. BALLADO'S THUNDER tracked the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and faded.
