MISTIE ROYALE taken in hand while saving ground, swung out for the stretch run, then rallied to be up late. SCAT A TAT TAT stalked the pace along the

inside, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to gain brief lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't hold off the winner. ON TIME AGAIN unhurried early, angled to the outside in the stretch and closed with a belated rally for the show. BLACK TRAIN outrun after being caught in tight early, saved ground and improved his position without threatening. STARSHIP PLEASANT stalked the pace three wide, made a run at the leader in the stretch, then gave way. MICHAEL'S ABBY chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, maintained the advantage to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. WHOODOO MEADOW very hard to load and fractious in the gate, trailed after breaking slowly, then gained some ground in the drive. DODIE JO stalked the pace into the far turn and faltered. HARD ROCK GIRL was not a factor. MRS OCEAN BREEZE stalked the pace four wide into the far turn, then faded. DR MAUREEN H raced three wide and was done early. WISE AND COZY set the pace along the rail into the far turn, then had nothing left.
