Footnotes

NICE TO REGAL rated along the rail, rallied and slipped through inside LADY GO GO to gain the lead at the top of the stretch, then drew clear while winning with something left. ACTING ON A FEELIN set the early pace, was outmoved by LADY GO GO down the backstretch, chased that rival around the far turn, then couldn't stay with the winner in the drive while continuing on with good courage to prove best of the rest. LADY GO GO chased the early pace, moved to take over racing down the backstretch while easing to the inside, made the pace to the top of stretch while coming out leaving room for NICE TO REGAL, then tired. TRANSFORMER hesitated at the start and failed to menace. BOSTON GARDEN tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. SOFIALEONOR unhurried early, circled rivals four wide around the far turn to loom a threat in midstretch, then faded. GUIGUE'S MIRACLE was outrun.
