FREE OF CHARGE outrun early, advanced along the rail into the stretch, angled outside the leaders in midstretch and rallied under pressure to be up late. HONGKONG CHARLEY chased the pace three wide, gained a slim lead inside the sixteenth pole but couldn't hold off the winner late. HI HO MARY sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, then gave way in the final sixteenth. AM FLIPPY chased the pace into the stretch and weakened. ANTAGONISER well placed racing along the rail, tired. NICKY TIKI was not a factor. TWILIGHT MIRAGE five wide around the turn, was taken up at the top of the stretch when SLIVER OF SILVER ducked into her and was pulled up. SLIVER OF SILVER racing four wide, ducked out unseating her rider when struck right handed by the whip leaving the turn.
