Footnotes

MONARCHOS was unhurried for a half mile, launched a rally nearing the far turn, made a strong six wide move to reach contention leaving the three-eighths pole, surged to the front at the five-sixteenth pole, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, shook off OUTOFTHEBOX in midstretch then drew away under a vigorous hand ride through the final eighth. OUTOFTHEBOX raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, worked his way forward five wide on the turn, made a run outside the winner to threaten in upper stretch but was no match for that one while clearly second best. INVISIBLE INK settled in good position for five furlongs, raced in traffic between horses on the turn, checked in tight leaving the quarter pole then finished strongly when clear to gain a share. DREAM RUN hit the side of the gate at the start, moved up between horses while three wide entering the backstretch, raced just behind the leaders while continuing between horses to the turn, edged closer in upper stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. SONGANDAPRAYER was strung out five wide while just behind the leaders on the first turn, moved up four wide to contest the pace along the backstretch, battled heads apart midway on the turn, dropped back slightly in upper stretch then weakened in the final eighth. IT'S SO SIMPLE was outrun for six furlongs, launched a rally leaving the turn, swung six wide entering the stretch then passed tired rivals in the middle of the track. YOU KNOW WHO angled to the rail soon after the start, raced well

back while saving ground to the turn then failed to threaten while improving his position. TALK IS MONEY bobbed a bit at the start, failed to mount a serious rally while racing wide. CITY ZIP rushed up between horses to contest the early pace, battled heads apart along the backstretch, surged to the front on the far turn, remained a factor to the turn, checked in tight quarters then drifted out in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. TURNBERRY ISLE (IRE) was unhurried for five furlongs, raced behind a wall of horses on the turn, checked while being bumped off stride in upper stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. CEE DEE was never a factor while racing wide throughout. TRAILTHEFOX sprinted clear in the early stages, dueled along the inside to the turn, drifted out bumping RADICAL RILEY in upper stretch then gave way. RADICAL RILEY checked slightly along the inside while just behind the leader on the first turn, raced up close while saving ground to the turn, checked while being bumped off stride in upper stretch then gave way.
