HONORABLE PIC quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside and was fully extended to prevail. BAND IS PASSING taken in hand at the start, angled four wide leaving the far turn and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. EL MIRASOL unhurried after being caught in tight at the start, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show. ROBERTO'S PRIDE allowed to settle, lacked the needed response in the drive. GONE FISHIN rated off the pace while saving ground, made a run at the leader along the hedge leaving the far turn, then weakened. DANCE THE BALLADO well placed into the stretch, tired. COCKTAILS AND LIES chased the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered. WERTZ was through after a half mile.
