Footnotes

LADY MELESI up close racing along the inside, came outside TINA DYNAMITE for the drive, rallied to catch that rival just inside the eighth pole and drew clear under a strong hand ride. TINA DYNAMITE quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside to midstretch, then was no match for the winner in the final eighth. OATSEE unhurried after bobbling at the start, advanced into contention on the far turn, angled out and gained the show while no threat to the top ones. LETTER OF INTENT unhurried early, saved ground while moving up on the far turn, angled out in the stretch and passed tired rivals. QUEEN OF KLUGS failed to menace. DYNATROL was no factor after being outrun early. ANNIE LIL chased the pacesetter into the far turn and tired. SOLAIA raced in striking position into the far turn and faltered. TERRY M. chased the leaders three wide to the far turn and faded. BRIGHT VICTORY raced four wide and was through after a half mile. MUSICAL was outrun after breaking slowly.
