GRAND HERITAGE rated off the pace, eased out for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be up late. GIN RUMMY CHAMP tracked the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead in deep stretch but couldn't hold off the winner in the closing strides. SOLDIER OF FAME unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and finished willingly to be up for the show. GOLD SHIELD outrun after drifting out on the first turn, angled wide in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. FLIGHT TO JUSTICE set the pace along the rail to inside the eighth pole and gave way. AUSTIN BARBER chased the pace to midstretch and tired. BACHELOR BLUES steadied along the inside on the first turn, saved ground into the stretch, then was steadied again when caught in behind the tiring pacesetter and failed to threaten. SOVERIGN HONOR tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and faded.
