Footnotes

EASILY unhurried early, was advancing when blocked in behind rivals on the turn, got through along the inside leaving the turn, angled out and rallied to catch FLYING CIRCLE nearing the sixteenth pole, then drew off. FLYING CIRCLE reserved after hitting the gate at the start, rallied along the rail to take over on the turn and drew clear but was no match for the winner late while clearly second best. SHE CAN PUNCH outrun after breaking awkwardly, passed tired rivals in the drive to gain the show. LEGEND chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. EYEFUL chased the pace four wide around the turn and faltered. UNPLUGGED chased the leaders five wide around the turn and faded. IT'S ABOUT ME steadied from tight quarters nearing the end of the chute, then was through after six furlongs. HALO JAMERICA showed speed off the rail into the turn, stopped and was eased in the stretch run.
