Footnotes

CENZONTLE stalked the pace, rallied three wide to take over midway of the far turn, then drifted out through the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. EDGE OF A SHADOW rated off the pace, rallied inside CENZONTLE to reach near even terms for command with that rival inside the eighth pole but was outgamed to the wire. NORMANDY TOWER allowed to settle, rallied three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. BORIS BAY set the pace along the rail, responded when headed by CENZONTLE on the far turn, continued on well to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. CAYMUS CAPOTE unhurried early, angled out leaving the far turn and improved his position. CHRISCODEY tracked the pace, made a run three wide to loom a threat on the far turn, then gave way. PECA JONES failed to menace. MILLENNIUM JET outrun early, was checked when caught in

tight leaving the far turn and never threatened. KHRUSHCHEV rated off the pace, was racing in contention four wide when forced out by CAYMUS CAPOTE leaving the far turn and tired. SON OF THE WEST pressed the pace outside BORIS BAY to midway of the far turn, then faltered. THUNDERBOLT IN MAY saved ground and faded. LASER was outrun and vanned off after the finish.
