**Footnotes**

OLD PARR raced five wide in the early stages, bid three wide on the turn, took over and drew away under urging. STARSHIP WARRIOR raced off the pace, moved up on the turn, came five wide into the lane and finished well down the middle of the track. GAMBARU was outrun early, swung seven wide turning for home and rallied mildly outside. BARRY K raced off the pace, came six wide into the stretch and rallied mildly. FOLLOW THE LEAD chased inside and failed to sustain a bid. BLACK TOP ROAD vied four wide early, chased outside, came five wide into the lane and tired. JOHARLINGTON raced between rivals, saved ground on the turn, angled out and lacked a rally. ONTHERAILWITHDAD dueled two wide and tired. STAMP OF APPROVAL dueled inside and faded. TRULY SMART was outrun. WITTY KID vied three wide, chased and gave way.
