GRAEME HALL raced four wide around the turn, rallied with CANFIELD and was all out to edge that rival to the wire. CANFIELD reserved off the pace, rallied three wide, then vied with GRAEME HALL through the late stages and missed. MAHABARAT bumped at the start, showed speed along the inside and gave way late. CAPTAIN RED chased the pace, made a run at the leader on the turn, then weakened. MR. PENTEL bumped at the start, chased the pace into the turn and faltered. COUNT BROCCO was never a factor. MR SONATA was outrun after being caught in tight at the start. A LITTLE PRECISE showed little after being squeezed back at the start.
