TRIPPI stalked the pace three wide, responded to pressure to catch ULTIMATE WARRIOR at the sixteenth pole and edged away. ULTIMATE WARRIOR sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail and continued on with good courage while unable to stay with the winner in the final sixteenth. HARLAN TRAVELER unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and rallied to be up for the show. SUN CAT reserved off the pace in striking position, lacked a late response. PERSONAL FIRST chased the pace along the inside and weakened. NUMBER ONE SHEIKH chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. BULLING showed little. DARWIN was eased through the final eighth after being outrun.
