QUITE A BRIDE quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside into the stretch, then increased her margin to the wire under a vigorous hand ride. WAQUOIT'S LOVE chased the winner along the rail into the stretch but was no match for that rival while continuing on with good courage for the place. EDEN'S CAUSEWAY reserved early, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show. PRISM well placed in behind the leaders, improved her position into the stretch but couldn't keep pace with the top ones. ARISTO rated off the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn to reach contention, then gave way in the drive. SUDDEN DESIRE saved ground and tired. IRISH TOUR off slowly, was never a factor. CRYSTAL BOWL chased the pace into the far turn and faltered. BROKE THE CODE reserved off the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then faded. NIJINSKY BULLET was outrun. SAPECA showed little.
