Footnotes

ENGLISH CHANNEL prompted the pace outside GULCH APPROVAL, moved to gain the lead from that rival at the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. MIESQUE'S APPROVAL outrun early, advanced into contention three wide around the far turn, angled out and closed well along the outside for the place. SILVER TREE rated off the pace, eased out and advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner late. GOOD REWARD reserved off the pace, rallied and slipped through along the rail to reach the leaders in midstretch, then gave way. GULCH APPROVAL set the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. BIG BOOSTER allowed to settle after breaking slowly, lacked a rally. MUQBIL stalked the leaders three wide into the far turn, then faltered. EVERYTHING TO GAIN was not a factor. FLIRT WITH FORTUNE was through early.
