**Footnotes**

OCALA ROCKET chased the pace, rallied to take over midway of the turn, then drew off under pressure. PAPA FRITA chased the pace into the stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the rest. TO HEIR IS HUMAN outrun early, steadied when caught in too close to the rail on the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and passed tired rivals for the show. AMARILLO SKY chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. PRONTISSIMO well placed early, faltered. CANCERBERO showed speed along the rail to midway of the turn, then had nothing left. MAGESTIC BILL raced three wide and faded. SEATTLE ZIPPER was not a factor. TWOFORONEBERT was outrun after stumbling at the start.
