Footnotes

HANSON HEIGHTS saved ground early on, then raced between rivals, rallied three wide through the stretch and won going away. WAR COLLEGE set the pace along the inside, dug in gamely and came again to earn the place. BAZINE stalked the leader, bid at the quarter pole, gained a short lead and was outfinished. HISTORICALLY tracked inside and gained mildly between foes in the stretch. RIVER LEMON was bumped at the start, raced three wide, four wide past the quarter pole and rallied mildly. KNOWA raced off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and closed belatedly outside. OH OH BAMA was bumped at the start, stalked three wide and lacked a stretch response. VANISHING BUCK raced off the pace, between rivals on the far turn and had no rally. EIGHTEEN TWELVE was bumped and steadied after the start, raced between rivals early, three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. TYLER'S WILDCAT raced three wide on the first turn and did not factor. MOUNTAIN CHAPEL was bumped at the start and pinched back, saved ground and did not

factor. TOMHANNOCK was bumped at the start, raced close up between foes, then saved ground and faded.
