QUEEN OF KING ST set the pace along the rail, repulsed a bid from SORTA SASSY in the stretch and drew clear under urging. SORTA SASSY chased the pace off the rail, made a run at the winner leaving the far turn and into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival while just saving the place. QUEEN'S AWARD reserved while saving ground, angled out in the stretch and rallied to just miss the place. CASA TUA rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and didn't do enough late. OUR DELIGHT tracked the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn, then tired in the drive. DRACUP was caught in tight at the start, tracked the pace and had no response when asked. MINER'S TUNE raced five wide and failed to menace. ALLURING POWER stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. VIRTUOUSLY trailed.
