NATHAN RIDGE reserved early, rallied four wide around the far turn to reach the leaders, responded to pressure and moved to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole, then edged away. SPARK OF HUMOR chased the pace, made a run to gain a slim lead at the quarter pole, maintained that advantage to the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. DECAF AGAIN rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals for the show. HURRICANE TIGER set the pace off the rail, responded when headed by SPARK OF HUMOR, stayed with that rival to inside the eighth pole, then tired. ANASHEED FLASH tracked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. BLUES BROTHER saved ground to no avail. BATTERY OPERATED tracked the pace into the far turn, then faded.
