Footnotes

TACKLEBERRY set the pace on the inside, responded when asked and dug in determinedly to prevail. SOARING EMPIRE raced four wide on the backside, three wide on the turn, bid three wide and continued gamely to the finish. TIZWAY pressed the pace, bid between rivals on the turn and dug in gamely between horses to the end. DUKE OF MISCHIEF raced three wide, between rivals, angled out in upper stretch and rallied outside. JACKSON BEND stumbled after the start, raced three wide, made a four wide run on the turn and finished evenly. RULE chased along the rail and weakened in the final furlong. PULSION raced inside and did not factor. OUR DARK KNIGHT raced between rivals, came three wide into the lane and tired.
