UNBRIDLED WIND outrun early, angled out for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be up late. GRAN MUJER (CHI) stalked the pace, moved to take over three wide leaving the far turn and drew clear, but couldn't hold off the winner late. CHATTER PATTERN prompted the pace along the rail, gained a brief lead on the far turn, then tired. MOP SQUEEZER reserved off the pace, lacked a late response. GOLD PRINCESS bumped with DECAPOLIS at the start, set the pace racing off the rail and faltered leaving the far turn. PRINCIPAL AFFAIR off slowly, saved ground and lacked a rally. DECAPOLIS bumped at the start, was never a factor.
